

Heavy Haul Transport #3 Second Leg Scheduled

Move set for 9 pm; Steel Plates to be laid on road at 8:15 pm

Hagåtña, Guam – Thursday, February 16, 2023 – The third heavy haul transport of components for the new Ukudu Power Plant will begin its second leg at 9 this evening. The Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) will leave the ITC area and proceed Northbound on Rt. 1 to Ukudu. 45 minutes prior to the start of the transport, crews will be laying down steel plates on the road for the SPMT to traverse over.

Alternate routes and live tracking are available at poweronthemove.org. The public is encouraged to use alternate routes to avoid traffic delays. One lane northbound will remain open. Sign up for PDN SMS alerts throughout the transport at guampdn.com under the Text Alerts tab.

The 22-axle Self-Propelled Modular Trailer (SPMT) will be carrying 175.8 metric tons of cargo. It will be the center of the transport convoy which will include a Guam Police Department escort, G4S Security, and Smithbridge trucks. The SPMT will end Transport #3 at Ukudu.
