

Median Restoration Begins Today on Rt. 1

Heavy haul transports have concluded; road work to finish on Aug. 24

Ukudu, Guam – Monday, June 26, 2023 – The heavy haul transport of parts and equipment for the new power plant located in Ukudu using Self-Propelled Modular Trailers (SPMTs) has concluded.

Median restoration along Marine Corps Drive, Rt. 1, began today and is scheduled to conclude on August 24, 2023. The construction and paving will occur on weekdays during non-peak hours, between 9 am and 3 pm. Today’s road work is occurring in Tumon at San Vitores Road and Illipog Drive in Upper Tumon, with the final median restoration scheduled for the Two Lover’s Point area at the end of August. There will be no road work occurring on July 4th.
